WELCOME TO TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN!

Below, you'll find the list of supplies that will help make your child's TK experience a productive one. As you enjoy your summer, please keep an eye out for school supply sales to take advantage of!

Required Supplies:

- 4 packs: 10 count Crayola* washable THICK markers
- 2 boxes: Crayola* crayons (24 count)
- 1 pair: Fiskar* brand scissors (child size)
- 12 count: Elmer's* glue sticks (.21 oz - disappearing purple; no large sticks please)
- 1 box gallon-sized Ziploc bags
- 4 boxes: tissues
- 3 large tubs: Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 2 boxes: fun, kid band-aids
- 1-2 bottles: hand sanitizer (with pumps)
- 1 reusable water bottle (our classroom drinking fountains remain closed), labeled with your child's name
- 1 backpack - large & roomy with a wide opening (NO WHEELS), labeled with your child's name
- 1 beach towel, labeled with your child's name

We specify the Crayola, Fiskar, and Elmer's brand products because we have overwhelmingly found that those brands hold up best to daily TK use.

- Stickers of all kinds
- Collage materials of all kinds

- 2 packs 10 count Crayola Washable THICK markers

Other supplies will be for your child's personal use. **Please label only those supplies noted below.** In some cases we have recommended a certain type or brand name **because we have found these brands to work far better than the alternatives.** Please restrict your child to boxes of **24 crayons**; more than this is difficult for a first grader to manage in a school setting. Where we have requested more than one of the same item, such as crayons, one will be saved for the second half of the year. We appreciate your cooperation and support, and look forward to an exciting first grade year.

- ☐ 1 backpack-This will come to school every day. It should be large and roomy, with a wide opening. **(label with name)**
- ☐ 1 box thin **Washable Crayola** Markers (classic or bold colors)
- ☐ 1 box thick **Washable Crayola** Markers (classic or bold colors)
- ☐ 2 boxes of **Crayola** crayons – **No more than 24 per box please.**
- ☐ 1 large eraser
- ☐ 2 highlighters
- ☐ 1 pair of scissors – **Children's Fiskar scissors work best (label with name)**
- ☐ 1 coloring or activity book **(label with name)**
- ☐ 1 clipboard (full size; packaging removed; **label with name**)
- ☐ 2 4 oz. bottles of **Elmer's** glue (no colored glue or gel)
- ☐ 2 **Elmer's** glue sticks
- ☐ 1 box of colored pencils (sharpened)
- ☐ 1 small whiteboard (with or without lines, 9x12 or smaller) **(label with name)**
- ☐ 1 whiteboard eraser **(label with name)**
- ☐ 1 box of Band-aids (any size)
- ☐ 4 **black** Expo dry erase markers
- ☐ 2 **medium** school toolboxes with a lid for organizing pencils, crayons, etc. **(label)**
- ☐ 1 box of Kleenex
- ☐ 6 pocket folders **w/o brads** (1 of each color – red, orange, green, yellow; 2 blue; **label with name on the inside cover**)
- ☐ 1 1.5" Clear-view Binder (Has clear pockets on the front and back covers – inexpensive variety. **Label with name** on inside cover and remove all labels.)
- ☐ 1 pair of wired headphones **(label with name)**
- ☐ 1 reusable, spill proof water bottle for daily use **(label with name)**

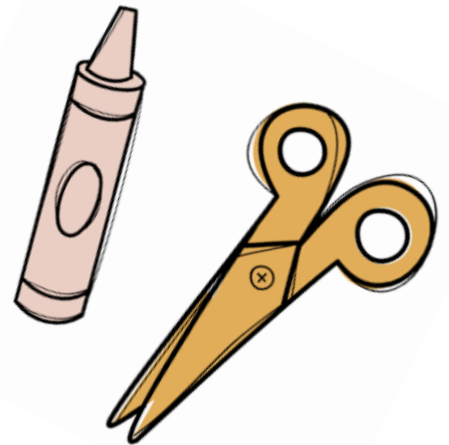
