



Avondale High School Personal Curriculum

The Michigan Legislature has provided an opportunity for students to slightly modify the State of Michigan graduation requirements. This modification is called a Personal Curriculum (PC). A student and his/her parent or guardian may request a Personal Curriculum for one of four reasons:

1. The student is interested in earning additional credits in math, science, English language arts, or foreign languages.
2. The student demonstrates a need to reduce the Algebra II requirement in the Michigan Merit Curriculum.
3. The student transferred from an out-of-state or non-public school after completing two years of high school.
4. The student has an individualized Education Program (IEP).

While a PC can be requested at any time during a student's high school experience, with the exception of social studies and math, it should be used in limited circumstances after students have had the opportunity to succeed in the Michigan Merit Curriculum.

The Request/or Personal Curriculum form, along with a copy of the student's Educational Development Plan, should be submitted to the student's counselor for consideration of a personal curriculum. Contact the counseling office for additional information.
