## Counseling Visits

How To Request A Meeting

#### Visits

The QR Code is posted around the building, in classrooms, & on the door of the Counseling Office.

- Research admission requirements & gather other documents.

  - Letters of recommendation
- Request transcripts through <u>Parchment.com</u>.
  - Submit application in a timely manner!

#### Transcripts

#### Go to Parchment.com

- "Order Transcript"
- Identify AHS as your high school
- Set up your account using your personal email & legal name
- Follow step-by-step instructions
- Type in the organization/college you wish to have your transcript sent

#### Steps

- You are responsible for requesting your final transcript through Parchment to be sent to the postsecondary institution you plan to attend.
- If your institution doesn't receive a final transcript showing that you graduated & earned a diploma, they won't let you register for second semester.
- Final transcripts will be ready at the end of June.
- You can still place your order after first semester, but you must select the "HOLD" FOR GRADES" option. If not, your transcript will be sent without your final senior-year grades.




