Seniors will receive this link via email and are responsible for submitting the form using their Avondale email.

**❖** MAY 11, 2026 AT 2:30 PM—DEADLINE FOR ALL ONLINE CLASSES

Seniors who need online classes to meet graduation requirements must finish & have a final grade by 2:30 PM on May 11. There will be no exceptions or extensions.

- ❖ MAY 14, 2026 AT 9:15 AM—AHS CONVOCATION PRACTICE

Seniors invited to Convocation Night will have practice in the auditorium immediately after 2nd hour.

❖ MAY 15, 2026—FAILURE TO COMPLETE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Any senior who fails to meet graduation requirements will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Seniors & caregivers will be notified by May 15th if their senior is not graduating.

## May 19, 2026 Details:

- BREAKFAST: 7:45 AM—The Senior Breakfast is hosted by the Junior Class in the cafeteria.
- MANDATORY GRADUATION PRACTICE: 9:00 AM—All seniors will report to the fieldhouse.
- AFTER THE PRACTICE, SENIORS WILL...
  - Pick-up caps & gowns from their counselor.
  - Settle fines (if applicable)—All books & chromebooks must be returned & fines must be paid
    before seniors can pick up graduation tickets. If these financial obligations are in order, the cap &
    gown package will be marked with a "GET TICKETS" tag.
  - Other requirements—Seniors must have their EDP complete on Xello & complete the <u>"Senior Exit"</u> Google form provided via email from <u>ahs.counselors@avondaleschools.org</u>.
  - Pick-up graduation ceremony tickets.
  - Wear cap & gown & line up for the SENIOR WALK.
- **SENIOR WALK**—In their cap & gown, seniors will line up two by two on the fieldhouse track to begin the ceremonial procession through the building. Caregivers & families are invited to attend & must enter through the vestibule doors by **10:00 AM.** They will line up on either side of Main Street, starting north of the cafeteria & along the main foyer in front of the fieldhouse. Seniors will make their way around & out of the building for the last time as AHS students.
- SENIORS ON TOUR—Seniors will have the opportunity to board one of three buses (Auburn grads will walk with an AHS staff member) & head to the Avondale elementary school they attended. They will parade through the building in their graduation gear. If a senior did not attend Avondale for elementary school, they are welcome to board a bus with a friend or may leave for the day. The buses will then return all seniors to the high school and are dismissed for the day.
- TICKETS—All seniors will receive graduation tickets. There will be no extra tickets available. Some families may have tickets they don't plan to use. Please feel free to reach out to other seniors & families if you want extra tickets!

## DON'T LOSE YOUR TICKETS! THERE WILL BE NO EXTRA TICKETS AVAILABLE FROM THE SCHOOL!

- THE CAP & GOWN—How to wear your cap & gown:
  - The graduation cap is worn flat on the head, parallel to the floor. The front point of the cap should be centered on the forehead.
  - Tassels hang on the right side & shift to the left after graduates receive their diplomas.
  - Seniors should dress in appropriate attire under their graduation gowns. (Examples: dress slacks, dress shirts, ties, & dresses that do not hang below the gown.)
    - Dress shoes with socks or dress sandals are required. Seniors may wear chunky heels or wedges. Athletic shoes, flip flops, & stiletto heels are NOT permitted.
    - Flowers, customized jewelry, sunglasses, & non-academic accessories MAY NOT be worn
  - Caps & gowns can be accessorized **ONLY** with academic regalia like stoles & honor cords.
  - Seniors MAY NOT decorate or place signs/symbols on their caps or gowns or toss their caps in the air.
  - Any senior not properly attired will be removed from the procession & not allowed to enter the fieldhouse.
