## 2025-2026 Seventh Grade Scheduling Update

Dear 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent or Guardian,

This fall your student will be attending 7th grade at Avondale Middle School. This transition brings opportunities for growth, excellence, and new experiences. We are confident that your 7<sup>th</sup> grader will enjoy their year at AMS and we have a dynamic team of teachers and support staff prepared to welcome them. As we prepare, we want to share information related to the steps for the transition from 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> grade. The overall scheduling process will begin as we work with our 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers, counselors, and administration to support placement for the 2025-2026 school year. The overall process for transitioning our sixth graders to seventh grade at Avondale Middle School has three important steps.

- <u>Step One</u>: AMS Counselor will visit 6<sup>th</sup> graders-Week of March 17th-Ms. Amico will visit with students in their Social Studies class during the school day to share with them all they need to know about scheduling requests for next year.
- <u>Step Two:</u> 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents complete course requests Due Wednesday, April 2nd. –All documents and directions will be on the AMS website under the *Curriculum and Scheduling* tab. These are not final placements as there is a selection process for some courses. Knowing what courses students would like to request helps us with planning. Questions about placement can be directed to the AMS counseling office.
- <u>Step Three</u>: Student Registration- Late August -All students come to register for the new school year and pick up their schedule of classes. <u>We will send you information regarding registration in early August.</u>

All students have two hours of exploratory classes in their schedule. Exploratory class scheduling begins with each student choosing whether they would like to participate in a full year music option (Band or Choir). If no prior music experience, courses will require an audition with the teacher prior to placement in the class. Students who take a full year elective will then be scheduled into Health and PE. All seventh grade students must take **one semester of Health and one semester of Physical Education**, to complete curriculum requirements. Students who do not participate in a full year elective course will be scheduled into a combination of the following elective options; Art, Spanish, French, Careers, Leadership, STEM - App & Animation, Stem - Flight & Space. **\*\*Elective classes will run based on student requests and may change.** 

Intervention and academic support classes will be substituted in the elective hours as recommended.
