
# Advanced English 7

#### \*If you're not in the class this year and you'd like to be, the criteria is:

- Minimum score of 70th Percentile or higher on <u>both</u> the <u>Fall and Spring</u> NWEA/ELA test in 6th grade.
- Current ELA teacher recommendation
- Strong reading and writing skills
- Strong work ethic/consistently completes classwork homework on time



# Advanced Math 7

#### <u>Placement criteria-</u>

\*All students <u>currently enrolled</u> in Advanced Math 6 will continue (unless you opt out. Please write a note for your counselor on your yellow scheduling card if you don't want to be in the class anymore).

#### \*If you're not in the class this year and you'd like to be, the criteria is:

- Minimum score of 70th Percentile or higher on <u>both</u>
   the <u>Fall and Spring</u> NWEA/Math test in 6th grade.
- Teacher recommendation from current math teacher Strong work ethic/consistently completes classwork and homework on time

# **STEM Options**



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#### **STEM 7 - App and Animation Creators**

Students explore computer programming, app development, using Code.org ,and MIT App Inventor, and other online development tools. They learn graphic design, event-driven programming, debugging, and algorithm creation using variables and conditional logic. They create apps and fun interactive games that apply these concepts and use basic user interface features, media, and animation.


#### STEM 7 - Flight and Space

The exciting world of aerospace comes alive through Flight and Space. Students explore the science behind aeronautics and use their knowledge to design, prototype, and test model rocket fuel and a glider. Students will also get to experience virtual space travel simulations and projects.

# More Semester Elective Options

- Art 7-2D and 3D media; can take the course if you had art in 6th grade.
- <u>Careers</u>-Explore your interests, values and aptitudes to learn future opportunities for employment and career pathways.
- <u>French 7</u>-Introduction to French culture and language; <u>can</u> take the course if you had French in 6th grade.
- Spanish 7-Introduction to Spanish culture and language; can take the course if you had Spanish in 6th grade.
- Leadership 7-This course is for students who want to make a positive impact on AMS and beyond. Must have the ability to work hard both independently and in a group setting.


